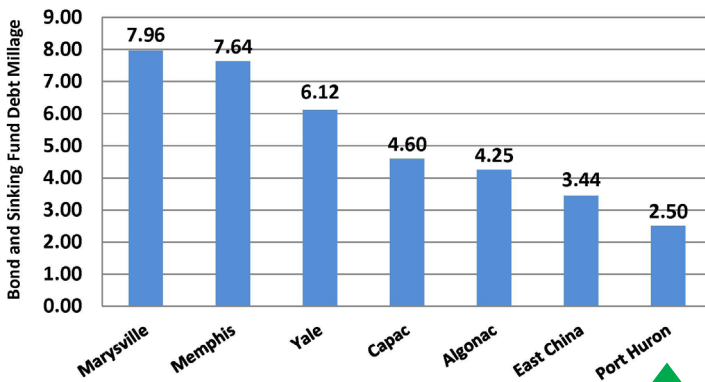

Port Huron Schools currently has the **lowest** millage rate.

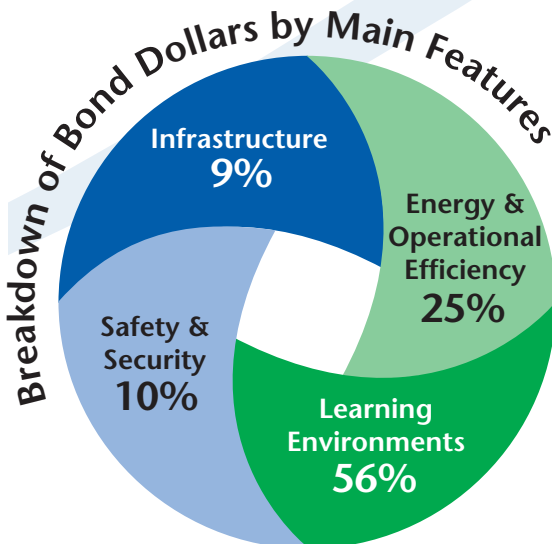
May 3rd proposals would increase millage to 6.05 mills - the midpoint of county districts.
