

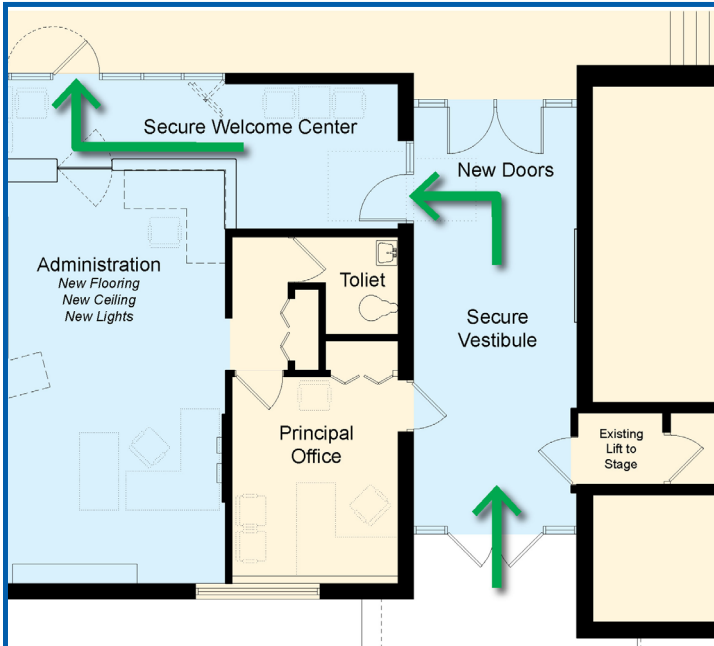

Security & Safety



This plan depicts how visitors would be redirected through the renovated vestibule and office area for enhanced security for students and staff.

One of our primary goals as a school district is to provide safe yet welcoming environments for our students, staff and families. Our district's 2011 Bond Program supported this by providing security cameras, keyless entry systems with card readers, and main entry lockdown mechanisms for all of our schools. The current bond program will complete the need for ALL buildings in Port Huron Schools to have secure welcome centers. These additional centers will be at both high schools, our three middle schools, the Harrison Center, and the remaining five elementaries that do not presently have them. New enhancements will include the following:

- School entries will be remodeled to redirect the flow of visitors into the building. Vestibules will be constructed or reconfigured to require visitors to enter through the main office. School offices that are not located near a school's main entrance will be relocated to the front of the building.
- All schools will receive upgraded P.A. systems, fire alarms, new emergency lighting, new exit lighting, and additional security cameras.
- Other safety measures include expanding and replacing parking lots, new exterior lighting, and replacing deteriorating sidewalks as well as asphalt play areas

Safety will be enhanced through secure welcome centers, additional lighting and enhanced technology, i.e. cameras, electronic latching devices, etc.
